*4th-5th day:* Plain sandy forest with dense narrow ride network, diverse runnability. (35 km)

**Competitor's point = 100- (competitor's time – winner's time)/ winner's time \*100.**

If a competitor is disqualified or not started, gets 0 points for that day.
